


DIRECTIONS



From I-10 West, follow I-10 until you see signs for I-295 North to Savannah, Georgia. You will EXIT I-10 from the RIGHT LANE. Follow I-295 North to I-95 North. EXIT left at Savannah, GA/Airport EXIT. Continue on I-95 to Exit 1, St. Marys Road. Turn RIGHT onto St. Marys Road. Continue on St. Marys Road until you reach FRANKLIN Gate, Subase Kings Bay. Enter through FRANKLIN GATE and travel on USS BENJAMIN FRANKLIN RD to the SECOND stop light. Turn right on USS DANIEL WEBSTER Road. Eagle Hammock rests about 1/4 mile on the left.

From I-95 North, EXIT I-95 at EXIT 1, St. Marys Road. Turn RIGHT onto St. Marys Road. Continue on St. Marys Road until you reach FRANKLIN Gate, Subase Kings Bay. Enter through FRANKLIN GATE and travel on USS BENJAMIN FRANKLIN RD to the SECOND stop light. Turn right on USS DANIEL WEBSTER Road. Eagle Hammock rests about 1/4 mile on the left.

From I-95 South, EXIT I-95 at EXIT 1, St. Marys Road. Turn LEFT onto St. Marys Road. Continue on St. Marys Road until you reach FRANKLIN Gate, Subase Kings Bay. Enter through FRANKLIN GATE and travel on USS BENJAMIN FRANKLIN RD to the SECOND stop light. Turn right on USS DANIEL WEBSTER Road. Eagle Hammock rests about 1/4 mile on the left.

If FRANKLIN Gate is closed, turn left on SPUR 40, before crossing onto base entrance. The next gate, STIMSON, will be open. Proceed through gate through two lights, make a right onto USS DANIEL WEBSTER Road. Continue through next light and Eagle Hammock rests about 1/4 mile on the left.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Eagle Hammock has fifty RV sites equipped with paved pads, water, sewage, and electrical hook-ups, picnic tables, and fire rings. Five sites and one restroom are American Disability Act compliant. A community center will offer meeting space, a kitchen, and Internet connectivity, along with a no-cost laundry room and a bathhouse.

RESERVATIONS & ELIGIBILITY

Eagle Hammock RV Park is open to active duty military (all branches), reservists, retirees, DoD Civilians, family members and their guests. ID cards are required at check-in.

Reservations are accepted 180 days in advance from active duty military and reservists, 160 days in advance from military retirees, and 60 days in advance from DoD civilians. Maximum rental time is 14 days when the park is full.

Check in time begins at 2 p.m., after 6 p.m. a camp host is available to check you in. Check out time is noon.
